“Sleepover” Code of Conduct

To ensure that the “Sleepover” Program is a safe and rewarding experience for all participants, a few basic rules need to be observed.

1. After arrival, **no student will go outside of the building** until the program ends on Saturday morning, unless he/she is authorized to do so, and is accompanied by a staff member.
2. Vandalism of any kind is, of course, unacceptable and will result in damage being paid for by the individual causing it.
3. Students will follow **all instructions** given by the staff, including those regarding “lights-out” time.
4. Violation of other students’ rights is not acceptable.
5. Students **must remain with the group**. Being in an “unauthorized” or “off limits” part of the building is a violation of this code of conduct.
6. No illegal substance of any kind (including tobacco) is allowed.

We understand that violation of these rules will result in being dismissed from the “Sleepover”. If such a circumstance occurs, parents will be called to pick-up their child, regardless of the time of day.

I hereby authorize my child to participate in the “Sleepover” and acknowledge reading, and accepting, the “Code of Conduct” above.

I authorize emergency medical treatment by medical personnel for my child in the event that I cannot be reached, if such treatment is necessary.
